

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Withdrawal of the declarations under Articles 5(2)(a) and 13(1) of the Geneva Act: Syrian Arab Republic

1. On April 13, 2025, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) received from the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic the notification of the withdrawal of its declarations made on February 5, 2009 under Article 5(2)(a), whereby an application for the grant of protection to an industrial design shall contain a brief description of the reproduction or of the characteristic features of the industrial design that is the subject of that application, and Article 13(1), whereby designs that are the subject of the same application shall form a homogeneous unit, of the Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs (“Geneva Act”) (refer to [Information Notice No 1/2009](#)).
2. In accordance with Article 30(3) of the Geneva Act, the said withdrawal of the declarations will take effect on July 13, 2025.
